Subject: Allotment, schedule & instructions w.r.t. electives for MBBS Batch-2022.....reg.

- The MBBS students who are currently pursuing Third MBBS Part-I (i.e. Batch 2022) are hereby allotted the electives as per their choice/ availability (allotment matrix enclosed at Annexure-I).
- The electives would be held in two blocks of 15-days each, i.e. first block: from 01st
 December to 15th December 2025; and second block: from 16th December to 31st
 December 2025.
- 3. During the First Block (i.e. from 01st December to 15th December 2025), Roll Nos. 1-125 shall undergo electives in pre- and para-clinical subjects, while Roll Nos. 126 onwards shall undergo electives in clinical subjects. During the Second Block (i.e. 16th December to 31st December 2025), it shall be vice versa, i.e. Roll Nos. 1-125 shall undergo electives in clinical subjects, while Roll Nos. 126 onwards shall undergo electives in pre- and para-clinical subjects.
- The students having electives in pre- and para-clinical subjects will have their clinical postings as per schedule, while those undergoing electives in clinical subjects will NOT have clinical postings.
- The students' are advised to get in touch with the HoD/ Nodal faculty of the concerned department for the same.
- The Students' are required to maintain the log book for the electives, the PDF format of which has been uploaded on the MAMC website. The students' need to download and take a printout of the same.

- The student is responsible for getting the entries in the log book verified by the internal and external preceptor (if applicable) at regular intervals.
- At the end of each block, the certificate needs to be signed by the Internal Preceptor and the Head of the Department.
- At the end of Second Block (i.e. ending on 31st December 2025), the concerned Head of the Department needs to forward the log book to the Department of Medical Education, MAM College, for signatures of the Dean, MAMC.
