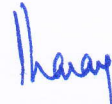

Subject: Allotment, schedule & instructions w.r.t. electives for MBBS Batch-2020.....reg.

1. The MBBS students who are currently pursuing Third MBBS Part-I (i.e. Batch 2020) are hereby allotted the electives as per their choice/ availability (allotment matrix enclosed at Annexure-I).
2. The electives would be held in two blocks of 15-days each, i.e. first block: from 15th March to 31st March 2024; and second block: from 01st April to 15th April 2024.
3. During the First Block (i.e. from 15th March to 31st March 2024), Roll Nos. 1-125 shall undergo electives in pre- and para-clinical subjects, while Roll Nos. 126 onwards shall undergo electives in clinical subjects. During the Second Block (i.e. 01st April to 15th April 2024), it shall be vice versa, i.e. Roll Nos. 1-125 shall undergo electives in clinical subjects, while Roll Nos. 126 onwards shall undergo electives in pre- and para-clinical subjects.
4. The students' are advised to get in touch with the HoD/ Nodal faculty of the concerned department for the same.
5. The Students' are required to maintain the log book for the electives, the PDF format of which has been uploaded on the MAMC website. The students' need to download and take a printout of the same.
6. The student is responsible for getting the entries in the log book verified by the internal and external preceptor (if applicable) at regular intervals.
7. At the end of each block, the certificate needs to be signed by the Internal Preceptor and the Head of the Department.

8. At the end of Second Block (i.e. ending on 15th April'2024), the concerned Head of the Department needs to forward the log book to the Department of Medical Education, MAM College, for signatures of the Dean, MAMC.
