TASK FORCE COVID LNH (TFCL)

A meeting of the Covid19 Management Task Force for MAMC and LNH created by the MD LNH vide order No PS/MD/LNH/2020/NIL dated 24-3-2020 was held on the 25th March 2020 at 1100. The following decisions were taken:

1. The designated isolation facility for suspected or confirmed cases will be New Special Ward Block, which has a separate entrance and is a separate block by itself. 60 isolation beds would be created at NSW. **Named C1.**
2. ICU management of Covid Diagnosed patients will be carried out at the Sushruta Trauma Centre, which will have ICU, HDU and operation facility for such patients. 24 ICU/ HDU beds and 30 Step Down beds would be created at STC. Any diagnosed case of Covid requiring surgery will be operated at STC. Patients requiring ICU care will be shifted in Advanced Life Support Ambulances from NSW to STC as per protocols. **Named C2.**
3. Screening of patients will be carried out outside main entrance of emergency of LNH. **Named S1.** Suspect cases will be transported by ambulance to NSW isolation wards. The parking outside the NSW would be vacated to create make shift Screening OPDs in case the demand surges. **Named S2.**
4. All the designated areas will have proper provision of PPE as per protocols and guidelines of DGHS,GOI.
5. All the areas requiring PPE kit will have designated Donning and Doffing areas. The disposal of the used PPE would be as per the guidelines and protocols.
6. Routine OPD services in LNH would need to be closed to mobilize manpower for management of rota for all categories of healthcare providers.
7. Emergency services will continue to be provided from the main Casualty Block of LNH.
8. The floors in the emergency block where the patients have been isolated or admitted would be vacated, sanitized and sealed for Two weeks.
9. No healthcare provider will enter the designated Covid facility without proper PPE as per DGHS norms.
10. Quarantine facility for doctors and other categories of staff would need to be created immediately.
11. A maximum of 25 % of staff would be taken from every department to create the rota including pre and para-medical departments except those providing laboratory facilities for Covid.
12. Medical officers and other non-teaching specialists will add to the pool of doctors providing care.

13. Duty rota for all categories will be changed subject to the daily availability of PPE at all the designated areas.
14. Medical Director LNH shall solely be responsible for provision of PPE, accommodation for quarantine for all staff and providing of various categories of staff.
15. The Task Force shall constitute sub-committees for Micro planning and Division of work.
16. In the absence of proper Donning and Doffing areas, provision of quality PPE and immediate availability of quarantine facility, the implementation of the rota will not be possible.
17. The Committee has ensured that with the current plan, there will be no intermixing of healthcare providers or Covid patients with the patients or relatives or other healthcare providers working in non-Covid areas of the hospital.
18. All departments will be asked to name a faculty as Task Force Coordinator who will prepare the list of residents and doctors from their respective departments.
19. All trauma patients going to STC would be diverted to Emergency Casualty of LNH.
20. 200 isolation beds to be created at The PHC/CHC at Pooth Khurd. This will make provision for a total of 300 beds from MAMC LNH.


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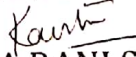

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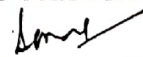
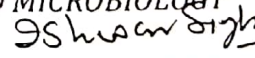
